

Glossary

Advent - the first season of the church year, leading up to Christmas

Covenant - an agreement

Eucharist - the Christian service commemorating the Last Supper

Holi - a Hindu festival, marking the end of winter

Paschal candle - a large candle placed by the altar in a church, which is lit on Holy Saturday until Pentecost

Prophecy - a prediction of what will happen in the future

Purim - a Jewish holiday commemorating Jewish people being saved from Haman

Ritual - a series of actions performed according to a prescribed order

Submission - accepting or yielding to a superior force
